A deposit of £100 is paid on acceptance of a place in the school and is returned when the pupil leaves.

HYMERS FEE REMISSION SCHEME

Hymers College operates a Fee Remission Scheme to enable children to attend when parents are unable to pay the full fees. Under the scheme, financial help up to the full value of fees may be available, dependent upon family income and assets. If total family income is below £46,000 per annum, you may be eligible for some assistance. If it is below £14,000 per annum, you may not need to pay fees at all. This will be at the discretion of the Governors and will be subject to interviews with the parents or guardians. Any assistance given will be re-assessed annually.

The Hymers Fee Remission Scheme requires a full declaration to be made of income and assets. The Bursar will be happy to give confidential advice to existing or prospective parents about eligibility under the scheme.

PAYMENTS

Fees and charges are due for payment on or before the first day of term, unless prior arrangements have been agreed in writing with the Bursar. Interest charges of 2% per month or part of a month are charged on balances outstanding after the first day of term if no such arrangement exists. Charges made by the school's bank in respect of uncleared payments will also be passed on to the parent or guardian concerned. There is no additional administrative or interest charge to parents who pay the fees by instalments under the direct debit scheme.
